Dear SIP Friend,

The Stouffville Igoma Partnership (SIP) is seeking your support for our 15th Annual Dinner & Silent Auction being held on Friday October 18, 2019 at Spring Lakes Golf Club. Thanks to the ongoing and generous support of our Stouffville community members, corporate partners, local businesses and the Town of Stouffville, SIP continues to have a positive impact on the lives of those living in Igoma, Tanzania.

SIP is run by volunteers in Canada so approximately **90 cents of every dollar** donated goes directly to the people and programs run by SIP in Igoma. The contributions at last year's event have helped SIP sustain its ongoing programs such as:

- Employ over 40 local residents to operate the Urafiki Health Clinic (UHC) 24 hours per day, 7 days per week servicing over 500 residents a month
- Support 113 children through the SIP child sponsorship program providing families with food, shelter, clothing, educational supplies, a mosquito net and health care for each child and two of their guardians at the Urafiki Health Clinic
- Provide tuition support for 50 secondary students and 10 young adult Igoma residents to enroll in trade school and gain skills in programs such as masonry, carpentry, electrical, plumbing, motor mechanics, computer literacy and food services
- Distribute hundreds of lifesaving mosquito nets to protect families against malaria
